Footnotes

BECKY'S KITTEN contently tracked the unopposed leader from the inside, slipped to the outside during the run around the far turn, got set down entering the stretch, drove his way to the front by the end of the furlong grounds and kicked away. MINNIE PUNT rode the rail, got checked ,stuck in traffic

approaching the quarter pole, tipped slightly to the outside at the head of the stretch, altered course further to the outside a few strides later, finished well to grab the place. ASSURED VICTORY rated along the inside on open lead until the quarter pole, got caught. BUNDESTAG (GB) took the inside route until midstretch, flattened out after angling to the outside. MIKE AND ROB three wide at the five-sixteenths marker, lacked the needed late response. MYTHICAL HERO in the three path during the later stages of the run around the far turn, had no rally. IN MY EYES at or near the inside for nearly three-quarters, encountered some traffic prior to the top of the lane, came up empty. AWAKE AT T WIRE hard to load, was strung out three wide on the opening bend, was one path wider on the next one, bumped hard with SUNNY SOL RIO and got knocked sideways spinning into the lane. JADE RUN saved ground to the end of the backstretch while never menacing. SUNNY SOL RIO four wide departing the backstretch, was jammed up a bit entering the stretch, eventually making solid contact with AWAKE AT T WIRE. WISHINGONADREAM failed to contend. MR. ESPRESSO raced from off the inside, was under a drive racing on the far turn, ducked over to the rail coming to the quarter pole, faded.
