TOO MANY, hustled along outside, advanced three wide on the turn, caught pacesetter MISS THERMAL TECH approaching the eighth pole and drew clear under a drive. MISS THERMAL TECH quickly sprinted clear, set the pace along the inside, could not handle the winner in the final furlong but continued on well to save the place spot. STALWART'S SECRET rallied inside on the turn, came wide into the stretch and was going well from the outside late. IRISH CAT, outrun early, raced inside on the turn, angled out in midstretch and finished well. MAE I. chased inside and lacked a rally. WEDGEFIELD raced three wide and tired. M' LADY'S HONOUR chased three wide and tired. SWEET RUNNER was finished after a half mile. TWO PUNCH CHRISTY broke awkwardly, raced on the rail and tired.
