PRAIRIE PRINCESS, rated inside, rallied three wide approaching the stretch and drew clear under a drive. SOUTHERN IVY, outrun early, advanced inside on the second turn, came wide into the stretch, was caught in traffic in upper stretch, was steadied, then finished gamely inside. GAVIOLA, rated along outside, rallied wide on the second turn and stayed on gamely outside. CITI PEARL, rated inside, advanced inside on the second turn, was caught in traffic in upper stretch and lacked a solid finishing punch. TIPPITY WITCH, rated outside, raced wide on both turns and had no impact on the outcome. WRAPS N TIPS, rated between rivals, came wide for the drive but lacked a rally. LOOW KEY pressed the pace from the outside and tired in the stretch. I MET SOMEBODY raced close up inside, saved ground into the stretch and was taken up along the inside in the drive. TUNABILITY set the pace and tired in the stretch.
