QUEUE was unhurried while outrun early, advanced four wide on the final turn, responded when roused and drew clear under a drive. SWEETEST THING was bumped at the start, raced close up while between rivals and dug in gamely along the inside through the stretch. LADY DORA was unhurried early on, rallied three wide approaching the stretch and stayed on gamely to the finish. KRISADA was outrun early, raced inside on the turns, angled out in upper stretch and finished well outside. MOON QUEEN (IRE) argued the pace from the outside and weakened in the final furlong. SUMMER SOLSTICE (IRE) was bumped and pinched back from between rivals at the start, was rated inside, put in a run on the last turn and had little left for the stretch drive. CRUISE ALONG was bumped at the start, was outrun early, raced wide and had no rally. KRIS PIT was rated inside and had no response when roused. AFFIANCED (IRE) raced with the pace while three wide and tired after the opening mile. CAVEAT'S SHOT dropped back early and had no response when

roused. BOWL OF EMERALDS raced outside and tired. ALIDA chased the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. BAIL BOND argued the pace along the inside and tired.
