Footnotes

BEHRNIK was unhurried outside early on, rallied three wide into the stretch and drew clear under a drive. PUNCHIN' GAL contested the pace while three wide and dug in gamely along the inside in the stretch. FIDGET raced close up outside, put in a four wide run on the turn and tired in the final furlong. MISS PARK PLACE was bumped after the start, raced wide and had no rally. KINGS EMPRESS chased the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. VROOM HILDA was pinched back after the start, raced between rivals and had no rally. BUTTERFACE was bumped after the start, raced wide and tired. HAPPY FACE was bumped after the start, argued the pace for a half mile and tired. JULES FOR A. J. raced inside and tired.
