LITIGATE broke slowly, after hesitating momentarily as the gate sprung open, then being taken off of to head off any intentions after ducking inward, was allowed to settle into stride, angled out nearing the five-sixteenths pole, took off with sudden speed, fanned five wide into the stretch, sustained the momentum once straightened away, grabbed command soon after leaving the furlong grounds, and drew clear, while never being asked for his best. GOLD RAPTOR underwent a three wide pursuit and held well to procure the place. FINAL VOW disputed the pace from the outside with RUDY RUDY RUDY, with both riders attempting to keep a bit in reserve all the while, shook free turning for home, emerged from the furlong grounds with a clear advantage, but was outfinished thereafter. ABLE BELLAMY within range along the outside, lacked a solid closing punch. TAP ATTACK tracked the frontrunners while riding the rail, angled outward entering the stretch, was forced to remain on hold, stuck behind several rivals just up ahead, and lacking any opportunity to angle outward for freedom, found room to alter course outward several paths at the sixteenth marker, and flashed good, but belated interest. GREY FOOSE lunged at the break, was guided over to the rail shortly afterwards, tracked the front runners while taking the inside route, managed to slip off the rail coming to the five-sixteenths pole, turned for home, but was forced to be kept on hold, stuck in traffic, tried twice to alter course outward, but was denied both times when a rival stubbornly held his ground, angled inward towards a newly-created narrow seam, closed in for about two jumps, before being stalled once more, when that opening was shut down, bided time, maintaining position as best as possible, gained the necessary optimal racing clearance coming to the sixteenth pole, but had left to offer by this point. PROWLER saved ground and was outrun. RUDY RUDY RUDY dueled inside and gave way.
