PREMIUM WINE away in good order, was put to a firm hold soon after the start, left the rail coming to the half mile pole, gradually ranged up to the pacesetter with the rider attempting to keep something in reserve all along, reached the quarter pole only heads apart for the lead, was asked for run a couple of strides into the stretch drive, dueled stubbornly, despite drifting out several paths, in response to left handed pressure, battled onward leaving the furlong grounds, now coming inward, in response to the switch to right handed pressure, poked a head in front deep stretch and finished with good determination to preserve it. SMOKIN HERO cleared the field in short order after the start, to take charge, showed the way along the inside unchallenged until nearing the quarter pole, got hooked up a stretch duel with the top one, fought gamely but had to settle for place honors. SIETE MACHOS reserved for nearly a half, displayed a good kick down the center of the strip to grab the show. GOOD CARD entered the turn from the four path, gave chase on the turn but was outfinished after turning for home. WISE STOP chased wide and gave way. HEAVENLY BLAZE saved ground and had no rally. VOSE THE HOST off a beat slowly, offered little. STORMIN BOLT three to four wide around the turn, tired.
