AMBIDAXTROUS took the inside route, gradually narrowed the gap from the front runner from midway on the far turn, cut the corner into the lane, angled outward in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, gained readily on the weakening leader, collared that foe leaving the sixteenth pole and edged clear. AUSTRALIS PRINCESS placed under a firm hold leaving the gate, was conceded the front by SPIRITUAL TUNE soon afterwards, spurred away to a long, comfortable advantage, continued along on the same scenario throughout the run around the second bend, saw the lead dwindle down, while beginning to shorten stride nearing the eighth pole, got caught in the late stages, but mustered up enough to preserve the place. SPIRITUAL TUNE away alertly, was taken hold off while conceding the front to the runner up, loosely tracked that opponent while racing along the inside, closed in under encouragement after entering the stretch, completing the last eighth displaying good courage to take the show. MUCH FANFARE lacked the needed response. THREE EMERALDS was no threat. WILD AWAKE lacked a solid kick. KALEIGH ROSE chased from afar and was outkicked. BLAZING HONOR three wide around the far turn, was outrun. D'LUCCI GIRL failed to menace. ARCTIC QUEEN raced three wide around the second turn and folded.
