EA well reserved, contently brought up the rear during the opening half, was placed three wide upon reaching the turn and made a sustained run from there to advance into contention, turned for home with the front runners well in sight and got called for more run, worked his way to a clear advantage before completing the next eighth, edged away in the final furlong under steady encouragement to the wire. LUNAR FLEET away alertly sparred with HOCKLEY almost from the get-go, while taking the inside route, needed some urging by the five-sixteenths pole to keep pace with the aforementioned foe, had no answer for the winner during the stretch run, but gamely got the best of his fellow pace combatant for place honors. HOCKLEY rated while dueling with the runner up from the two path until the quarter pole, got out finished leaving the furlong grounds. REGAL WARRIOR chased the duelers four wide on the turn and weakened. RIGBY saved ground to no avail. RED LEADER stayed within range of the front runners, coaxed along from the two path, was under stronger handling spinning four wide into the stretch, failed to muster up a solid closing punch. RUFFINO off the inside, chased the ongoing pace dispute, began to back away by the five-sixteenths pole.
