**Footnotes**

WEE PARTY made contact with an errant HOLIDAY'S JEWEL at the start, went up to assume a forward position, patiently stalked the leader from the two path until the seven-sixteenths pole, was let out at that station and drew abreast of BE WITH ME by the three-eighths pole, raced on nearly even terms with that opponent for the remainder of the run around the bend, grabbed a sliver of a lead entering the stretch, got called upon, left the furlong grounds a full body length in front, saw the runner up cut that margin in half during the last eighth, but held safely to the end. HOLIDAY'S JEWEL bumped with the top one after getting away awkwardly, underwent a three wide pursuit, was put to encouragement by the five-sixteenths pole, gained ground steadily throughout the stretch run but fell short. BE WITH ME was rated along the inside setting the opening splits, felt the presence of the eventual winner by midway on the turn, turned for home inches behind that opponent, weakened thereafter into the show slot. RAISE THE FLAG saved ground, was put to a prolonged drive but made no impact. SCENIC GULCH faded off a ground-saving journey. SPELLING TEST lumbered along during the initial stages, continued along the outside on the turn and tired.
