Footnotes

AMYLIMEHOUSE was put to a firm hold stalking the leader from the outside, remained so throughout the opening half, got released from it as the stretch drive began, and took over, left the furlong grounds the clear leader and held sway. NO MORE STRESS well rated in the two path for a half, angled outward in upper stretch and came home willingly to procure the place. FORTHELOVEOF ANNA between rivals on the turn, got out finished. SUPER SLASH coaxed while sitting in the pocket, vacated the premises coming to the quarter pole, failed to draft behind the winner when coming up empty for the stretch run. IBERIAN GATE quickly cleared the field after the start, darted over to the rail, making it in plenty in time for the run around the bend, was put to the test by the winner entering the stretch, succumbed readily to that opponent's challenge and tired. SOTIQUE pursed the pacesetter three wide and was through after going a half. TWO MOONS departed the backstretch from the four path, folded.
