SATURDAY'S CHARM got away slowly, lagged at or near the back of the field for the opening half, departed the backstretch three wide, began to pick up the pace late on the turn, swung four wide into the stretch and commenced to rally in earnest. overtook the runner up a short distance past the furlong marker and edged away under good handling. RELOAD well reserved down the backstretch, steadily advanced into contention upon entering the turn, issued a challenge as the widest of three on nearly even terms with each other spinning into the lane, forged his way to a slim advantage by the end of the furlong grounds, relinquished to the top one soon afterwards but continued onward in willing fashion to secure second. CONSORTIUM stalked the front runners from off the inside, mustered up a mild response to grab the show. CHARLIE'S QUEST pressed the issue from the two path, ranged up to increase his presence leaving the midway point on the turn, challenged from between rivals heading for the quarter pole, kept up the pursuit for an additional furlong before backing away. HANNIBAL LECTER tracked the front runners while taking the inside route, appeared to get unsettled after QUORUM drew directly alongside nearing the end of the backstretch, had the rider check with a considerable loss of momentum and ground as a result of the action, didn't help his cause during the initial stages of the run around the bend, rankly fighting with vigor on the left side of the bit, was fanned about five wide into upper stretch, then tipped into the six path a little more down the road, had no impact. SLASH FIVE got off to an alert beginning, cut the pace from the two path for most of the way down the backstretch, tucked along the rail at the half mile pole, came under heavy pressure from two others nearing the head of the stretch, dug in well from upper to midstretch then weakened. QUORUM raced in midpack from off the inside, failed in an initial attempt to angle outward at the five-sixteenths pole, succeeded in the second try and started the stretch drive from the five path, offered little and tired.
