KHARAFa three to four wide in range just off the pace well rated, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, cornered four wide into upper stretch, rallied to seize command a sixteenth out, inched away in the late stages to prevail. PLAINVIEW well held on the pace along the inside, got let out cutting the corner into the stretch, dug in under a drive fending off a pair to the eighth pole, got headed nearing the sixteenth marker and held well just holding for the place. LUBASH just off the inside in mid pack, got set down angling four to five wide into upper stretch, rallied displaying late foot in the final hundred yards to garner the show just missing for the place. ABILIO attended the pace from just off the inside, got let out at the quarter pole, had the leader PLAINVIEW drift safely in front and angled inside coming to the final furlong, offered up a mild kick for the last major share. SPEAKING OF WHICH (IRE) two to three wide towards the rear, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, spun five wide for home, offered up a mild late bid but was unable to make an impact. BOMBAGUIA three wide in aim of the front, came under coaxing three furlongs out, swung three to four wide into the lane, offered up a mild bid but was out kicked. HAKAMA three to four wide towards the rear, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, cornered four wide for home and offered no response. COMPLIANCE OFFICER steadied in behind ABILIO as that foe crossed in front out of the chute, tracked the pace inside from mid pack, came under urging at the three-eighths and weakened. CLEAR ATTEMPT three wide towards the rear, came under urging midway on the turn, spun five wide for home and

tired. SAINT PIERRE stumbled badly at the start, became detached early on from the main body of the field while saving ground and trailed throughout.
