MR. SINATRA, unhurried along the inside early on, advanced steadily on the rail around the second turn, came wide into the stretch, caught pacesetter ROCK AND ROLL at the eighth pole and bested that rival under a drive. ROCK AND ROLL quickly showed in front, set the pace under pressure from DELAY OF GAME, shook off that rival and drew clear on the second turn then dug in gamely along the rail through the stretch but could not hold off the winner. ACCELERATOR dropped far back in the early going and was no real threat with a mild late rally. PRIVATE SONG, just to the outside of the winner for the opening half mile, put in a wide run on the second turn but had nothing left for the stretch drive. DELAY OF GAME pressed the pace from the outside and was finished after the opening three quarters.
