BUILDING NEW ERA raced close up early, rallied three wide into the stretch and was outfinished. HELENE'S DREAM was outrun early, came wide for the drive and offered a mild rally outside. SMOKE DIAMOND contested the pace from the outside and tired in the stretch. ONE GOODKNIGHT raced three wide and had no response when roused. CONRAD CROSSING raced wide and had no rally. KETCH UP BOY chased the pace while three wide and tired. JACKS EXPRESS was outrun along the inside. KISS THE DICE had no rally. NORTHERN STORM was finished early.
