Footnotes

KUGGERAND dueled early along the rail, shook loose in upper stretch and drew clear under good handling. THUNDER CHIEF settled in midpack, rallied between horses on the turn and finished willingly to best the others. TOM KITTEN was rated between horses and improved his position with a late run between horses. GOOD TO BE ME pressed the winner from outside and tired in upper stretch. JOBA saved ground for a half, angled between horses and lacked a strong closing bid. RIZZI'S COMET steadied at the start and was never a factor while wide on the turn. BUTTERFIELD ROAD raced up close inside, dropped back on the turn and was never close thereafter. AMERICAN VETERAN faded after going a half. HOLD YOUR HAT chased three wide and gave way. BISHOP OF NOLA was never a factor.
