Footnotes

JUDICIAL LEADER put to hand encouragement leaving the starting gate, took over the front from a reluctant GATTO NERO, showed the way rated along the inside until the quarter pole, began to shake off the closest pursuers late on the turn, entered the stretch and was called upon, lengthened away proceeding down the lane, kept busy to the end. DUBAI'S CONNECTION brushed with SAY TOBA SANDY at the break, tracked the pacesetter from the inside, angled outward and got up for the place. POPPY DAY placed four wide at the head of the stretch, rallied mildly for the show. PELICAN LAKE raced along the outside and had no rally. GATTO NERO broke on top, was put to a firm hold and was soon relieved of pace-setting duties by the eventual winner, stalked that rival from the two path, got let out a notch departing the backstretch, was put to stronger handling by the five-sixteenths pole attempting to keep pace, fell back nonetheless and steadily tired. SAY TOBA SANDY a bit unsettled just before the gate was sprung open, broke awkwardly, coming inward a step or two and making light contact with DUBAI'S CONNECTION, underwent a three wide pursuit, tired after completing a half. INDY'S FORUM ducked to the rail at the five-sixteenths pole, faded.
