Footnotes

ASSOCIATE patiently stalked the pacesetter from the outside, with the rider sitting chilly in the saddle with a firm grip on the reins, drew abreast of the leader in the vicinity of the seven-sixteenths pole, edged away continuing on her own power as she made her way to the quarter pole, drew off under a mild hand ride, interrupted only once as the rider shook the reins just prior to departing the furlong grounds. DAVID THE GREAT tracked the front runners from the inside during the opening stages, slipped into the two path and got asked for run near the three-eighths pole, proved no match for the top one. CITY TROOPER ducked over to the rail midway on the turn, was under a drive cutting the corner into the lane, held on well enough for the show. SHANKOPOTAMUS grabbed the early lead, showed the way from the inside, had the winner draw alongside leaving the half mile pole, yielded and fell back despite being asked for some run. PISTOLS AT DAWN underwent a three wide pursuit and folded. BERT B DON was never involved.
