Footnotes

LEILANI'S TICKET contently stalked the ongoing pace dispute from the two path until the five-sixteenths pole, angled outward into the three path at that station and swung into action, overhauled the battling front runners quickly after entering the stretch and arrived at the eighth pole comfortably in front, poured it on thereafter, despite drifting outward, crossing the finish line under hand urging. MY WAY OR DUBAIWAY initially involved in a three way skirmish, went at it one on one with SUNRISE LOVER from the two path during the run around the bend, proved powerless to stave off the successful challenge by the fresher winner in upper stretch, continued the battle with his fellow dueler the rest of the way and won that fight for place honors. SUNRISE LOVER spurred for control while taking the inside route, got out finished in the late stages for second. READTHESMOKESIGNAL briefly pressed the issue three wide, held on to best the rest. PATRIOTIC DUTY raced along the outside, got asked for a response by the half mile pole, was kept busy on the turn, failed to reach a contending position. EVERYOTHERDAYHERO was sluggish early down the backstretch, raced from off the inside, was taken outward until

in the five path by the three-sixteenths pole, had no kick. CALL FOR THE CLOCK stacked four wide at the half mile pole, was through after completing a half. SHADON lunged outward, resulting in making contact with GRAND AWARD at the start, settled into midpack and offered no serious bids. CAJUN BEST on the rail and roused by the midway point on the turn, came up empty. RED SHOGUN saved ground for nearly a half, was angled four wide into upper stretch, had no impact. GRAND AWARD got bumped at the start, tucked momentarily along the inside down the backstretch only to get placed into the two path, was outrun thereafter. MAC'S INK hung out in the overland route on the turn, had nothing left turning for home.
