FOR FILLIES AND MARES THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD ELIGIBLE FOR THE NEW YORK STALLION STAKES. Fillies and Mares that have been fully subscribed to The New York Stallion Series (all eligibility requirements met by their three year old season) are eligible to this race. \$1,000 to pass the entry box, \$1,000 to start. Three year olds, 122 lbs.; older, 124 lbs. Non-winners of \$30,000 on the turf in 2000 allowed 2 lbs., \$30,000 in 1999-2000, 4 lbs.; a sweepstakes in 2000; or \$15,000 three times in 2000, 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming and starter races not considered). Preference to start will be given in the following order: Stakes winners, high weights, lifetime earnings.

LOVELY AMANDA raced close up while in hand, rallied nearing the stretch, drew clear and stayed gamely while drifting out in deep stretch. KATIE'S CURE raced wide and stayed on well outside. TERREAVIGNE chased the pace and tired in the stretch. FICKLE FANNY quickly opened a clear lead, set the pace and gave way after three quarters. LAP KITTY had no rally. PHIL MY TANK had no response when roused. ANTHENIAN'S LEGACY raced wide and had no rally. BID'S FEMME tired. DOUBLY DEVIOUS chased inside and tired. PATTY'S POSITIVE was outrun. SOMETHING SLEAZY tired after a wide trip.
