COOL DAYS chased the pace along the inside, altered course to the outside in the stretch, dug in gamely and prevailed under a drive. CHRISTIAN X. was hustled along early, rallied four wide nearing the stretch and finished gamely outside. NEW YORK TOKEN contested the pace from the outside, drew clear into the stretch and tired in the final furlong. RODEO RUNNER was outrun early, advanced inside on the turn, angled out in the stretch and offered a mild rally outside. TOUGHER 'N MOST had no rally. BUSTERS RODEO was bumped at the start, contested the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. SEVEN BELLSFORBABA was bumped at the start, chased the pace while between rivals and tired. SAFARI raced wide and tired. POWER LINK chased the pace while three wide and tired.
