JALA FEVER broke running and took charge early, when THAT'S RICH was taken in hand and backed off, set a moderate opening half, well rated in the two path and facing only token pressure from the aforementioned rival, was set down simultaneously with that opponent coming to the three-sixteenths pole, then held that one as well as the late-closing runner up at bay under steady encouragement. AQUINO (URU) tracked the leader from the inside, came out in preparation for the stretch drive just past the five-sixteenths pole, angled three wide into the lane and finished willingly to win the place photo. THAT'S RICH away well from the gate, was taken in hand, conceding the front to the eventual winner, patiently stalked that foe, positioned in the three path and just off the pacesetter's hind quarters, was set down in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, but proved no match. KILN CREEK lacked the necessary stretch response. SLY within range while the leader was setting a leisurely pace, attempted to rally from the five path at the head of the stretch but wasn't up to the task at hand. SAWTOOTH MOUNTAIN was always inside and always outrun.
