Footnotes

BECKON patiently stalked the leader from the outside, drew abreast of that opponent at the five-sixteenths pole, matched strides while being kept on hold during the ensuing sixteenth, shook free after being let out a notch, then continued to edge away during the last eighth under good handling. QUE POSSE a bit skittish during the loading procedure, needed several attempts before being placed in the starting gate, came away in good order, was guided over to the rail coming to the half mile pole, took the inside route from there until the five-sixteenths pole, angled outward soon after settling into the stretch, then came home with good energy down the center of the track to be second best. PAWLEYS PORCH had the rider grab hold after leaving the gate, was unhurried during the opening half while bringing up the back of the pack, was taken outward late during the run around the bend, gearing up for the stretch run, angled five wide into the lane and mustered up enough of a kick to be along for the show. SMART REBEL chased three wide around the turn and tired. LLOYDOBLER off the inside, gave way after going a half. THE KAVORKA rated along the inside until the quarter pole, wilted.
