Footnotes

FRIVOLOUS BUCK sat reserved between rivals, departing the backstretch, gradually moved up from midpoint on the second turn, angled four wide into the stretch, having already been placed under encouragement, closed in relentlessly, then collared the leader in deep stretch to prove best. TUTTI VA BENE patiently tracked the leader while placed in the pocket, was forced to be kept on hold, lacking clear sailing as the field turned for home, didn't have a long wait, was set down and through a newly-created inside alleyway in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, finished with good energy along the inside to procure the place. PRINCESS MAURA broke open the gate prior to the start, was away in good order and swiftly, established command soon after the start, being guided over to the rail once sufficiently in front, set the pace towards the inside, under pressure for most of the opening three-quarters, edged away during the run through the furlong grounds, dug in stubbornly when the top one made her presence felt, before reluctantly yielding a couple of jumps before

the wire. CRAZY CATLADY reserved off the inside for nearly three-quarters, angled out for the stretch run and displayed a good kick en route for the last major share. MYSTIC CITY three wide around both turns, rallied mildly. CAGEY GIRL worked out a tuck into the two path before reaching the first turn, stalked the leader from there until nearing the quarter pole, was set down spinning into the lane, remained a forward factor until midstretch before flattening out. TRIPLE TAX EXEMPT saved ground and improved position in the lane. WHO IS LADY accompanied the leader from the outside until upper stretch and gave way. MS STILLETTO was no factor. MY MAGIC MOMENT four wide around the far turn, had no kick. CHARTREUX tired off a ground-saving journey. STARJETTA off a beat slowly, was strung out three wide around the first turn, failed to reach a contending position.
