DANCING ROMEO, rated along early, was taken up and carried out on the first turn when KILLER JOE broke down then rallied five wide and finished gamely. LIGHT BAGGAGE raced wide throughout. PROSPECTOR JOHN raced inside. JAKE THE GROOM put in a wide run on the second turn but had nothing left for the stretch drive. BACKSTREETS, rated inside, put in a run into the second turn but tired in the stretch. ADMAN chased the pace and tired. KILLER JOE, bumped at the start, broke down on the first turn.
