POINTS WEST was outrun early, rallied four wide on the second turn, dug in resolutely outside and prevailed after a stiff drive. FIDGET raced in hand early, rallied three wide approaching the stretch and dug in gamely to the finish. CANDYBEDANDY raced close up inside, saved ground and finished gamely on the rail. FOND quickly showed in front, set the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. SE ME ACABO (CHI) chased the pace while three wide and tired in the stretch. GIVE AND TAKE raced wide and had no rally. STAKE pressed the pace from the outside and tired after three quarters.
