BANK AUDIT quickly showed in front, set the pace along the inside, drew clear when roused and was kept to a drive to the finish. BALDOMERA was bumped at the start, was outrun early, raced inside and rallied on the rail to get the place. LILAH was bumped at the start, was outrun along the inside early, came wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. EBONY BREEZE was unhurried outside early on, put in a three wide run nearing the stretch and tired in the final furlong. EVERY TRICK pressed the pace from the outside and tired in the stretch.
