BLUES STREET was rated in the middle of the pack, made a four wide move on the turn, charged to the front in midstretch and edged clear under pressure. VALTRUS checked early, trailed to the turn, advanced three wide into the stretch and rallied belatedly. CLIFF MEADOWS was outrun for a half, steadied along the inside midway on the turn, split horses in midstretch and finished well to gain a share. LEMON CREAM PIE settled just off the early pace, lodged a bid between horses in upper stretch and flattened out. GIMME CREDIT saved ground early, angled between horses, raced just off the pace to the turn and finished evenly. BROAD RIVER saved ground and tired. YIELD BOGEY rushed up from outside, pressed the pace for six furlongs and gave way. A UNIQUE TREASURE was used up setting the early pace.
