KING CONGIE stalked the pacesetter from the outside under a good hold, was taken out to the three path soon after entering the far turn, gradually ranged up, was roused while angling three wide into the stretch, closed in on the leader, grabbed command leaving the furlong grounds and held sway, driving. CASINO HOST reserved off the inside for nearly three-quarters, was called upon turning for home, finished with a flourish between rivals during the stretch run en route for the place. COCKEYED ROOSTER cleared the field under a snug hold to take charge early, showed the way rated on a loose lead towards the inside until the quarter pole, was let out a notch with several rivals starting to crank up the pressure, wasn't able to stave off either of the two twosome but was kept together well enough to salvage the show. LACONIC bumped at the start, was put to encouragement angling four wide into the stretch and rallied willingly to grab the last major share. DERBY KITTEN rank while proceeding along the straightaway approach to the opening bend, blew that turn, bearing out two to three paths, remained well out in the course heading into the backstretch, went on to take the overland around the far turn yet still held reasonably well to the wire. SANDYS DIAMOND lacked the needed response. STORMY THE CAT bumped at the start, patiently rode the pocket, tracking the leader, issued a mild rail bid after entering the stretch, reached the leader's hind quarters with an eighth to go, but could make no additional headway. NORTHERN HAMMER loosely stalked the pacesetter from the outside and gave way. DIXON LANE was through after completing three-quarters. SHINE BOX underwent a three to four wide journey and had no kick. DAX was outrun. ELTHEEB failed to menace off a ground-saving trip.
