Footnotes

BRUNELLI raced within striking distance along the outside, was asked to pick up the pace swinging into the lane, tipped outward a bit for optimal racing clearance, closed in, wrested the lead in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole and edged away while being kept to the task at hand. GOTTA GO ROUND pressed the leader from the outside, moved up to make a bid for the lead coming to the quarter pole, took command, offered brief resistance before yielding to the top one at the sixteenth pole, but continued onward willingly enough to procure the place. RIZZI'S COMET angled three wide into the stretch and rallied for the show. KARAKORUM BUDMAN appeared unsettled just before the gate sprang open, spotting the competition a good two length head start, gradually moved into contention, then rallied mildly for the last major share. BILL SENIOR set the pace from the inside and gave way. CENTRIPITAL was no threat. SPENCERIFIC faltered after a half. SETTOP displayed brief foot. DIXIELORE forwardly placed for nearly a half, lost action, fell on the turn and was reported to have bled. There was a Stewards' Inquiry focusing on the incident on the turn before the result was declared official.
