### Footnotes

YOKAMA, rated along outside, advanced on the final turn, caught pacesetter BRISTOL CHANNEL approaching the eighth pole and quickly drew clear under a vigorous hand ride. MOMENTS OF MAGIC, rated along between rivals, came wide for the drive and finished with a rush from the outside to get the place. BRISTOL CHANNEL (GB) quickly showed in front, made the pace while in hand and stayed on gamely to the wire. SUNDAY AT ONE, rated along inside, saved ground into the stretch and stayed gamely despite lacking room along the inside in the drive. KARAKIA (IRE), rated along inside, angled out and put in a three wide run into the stretch then stayed on with courage to the finish. MISS NORTH BEACH, wrapped up along the rail, saved ground throughout and stayed on well along the inside. CELIBATAIRE (FR) leapt in the air at the break and was off behind the field then finished with good energy after a wide trip. IRISH DAISY, rated outside, put in a wide run on the final turn but had nothing left for the stretch drive. FICKLE FATE, rated along between rivals, had no rally. BORN TWICE dropped back after the start and had no response when roused. RAP AND DANCE chased the pace from the outside and stopped.
