Footnotes

AFRICAN KING dueled between horses for a half, opened a clear advantage in midstretch then dug in late to hold off the runner-up in deep stretch. CAVALLO PAZZO pressed the pace four wide to the top of the stretch but couldn't stay with the winner while narrowly holding for the place. MORE THAN A REASON was outrun early, swung four wide while gaining at the quarter pole and rallied belatedly in the middle of the track. SENECA SUMMER contested the pace three wide between horses into midstretch and weakened. CLEMENS moved up along the rail, dueled for a half and gave way. UNBRIDLED DANGER checked along the rail soon after the start and was never close thereafter.
