STRIKE THE MOON away alertly, quickly established command, showed the way from the two path, received a stiff challenge from TRULY DEVOTED after completing a half, turned back that opponent during a duel that lasted from the five-sixteenths pole to the three-sixteenths pole, then held sway under steady hand encouragement to the wire. KITNESS threw off the jockey and ran off down the chute before being apprehended by the outrider, prior to the start, proceeded to come out in good order, took the inside route throughout, responded well when given her cue in upper stretch, finishing with good energy, which was sustained for nearly a sixteenth of a mile past the finish line under light encouragement from the rider. TRULY DEVOTED patiently stalked the leader from the three path for nearly a half, ranged up to issue a challenge for command, fought intensely from the five-sixteenths pole to three-sixteenths pole, with both horses being fully roused, was shaken off, and eventually weakened into the show slot. ISLAND SCHOOL saved ground, angled to the middle of the strip in upper stretch and rallied mildly. HOOPSKIRT three wide leaving the backstretch, needed a strong hold on the left rein by the rider to keep from bearing out on the turn, failed to reach a contending position. BELLA REGINA four wide around the turn, was no threat. THIRD ROW CENTER broke outward at the start, raced off the inside and was eased coming to the eighth pole.
