BIG BROWNIE patiently tracked the front runners under a firm hold from the pocket, turned for home with a clear alleyway along the inside, charged through under good handling to take command then drew off during the final eighth under steady encouragement. WE NEED V L T'S strung out four wide at the three-eighths pole, proved no match for the top one during the stretch drive, but finished with good courage nonetheless to take the place. RAFFIE'S ROSE took the overland route around the the turn and outkicked the others for the show. MOTHER RUSSIA moved up under her own power to grab the early lead, was rated towards the two path, was let out shortly after entering the stretch, with no fewer than three foes bearing down, readily succumbed and faded during the last eighth. BRETTON WOODS was taken off the inside at the seven-sixteenths pole and had no rally. HEALTHY DEBATE prompted between rivals from the three path around the bend and folded.
