SUROOF broke alertly, and was soon placed under a firm hold, readily yielded the front nearing the opening bend, took the inside route prior to being eased to the two path entering the backstretch, patiently stalked the leader from there, being rated all the while, lost contact with that rival midway around the far turn, was set down turning for home, gained readily on the hand urged leader, grabbed the lead in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, then reached the wire in the nick of the time to narrowly prevail. DEANAALLEN'SKITTEN was content to lag in the back of the pack during the initial half mile while taking the inside route, slipped outward entering the far turn, circled past rivals with a bold four wide sweep during the run around the second turn to reach a contending position by the quarter pole, sustained the momentum swinging four wide into the lane, closed with good energy only to run out of ground. SMART FARMING saved ground, and outkicked by the top pair. YESTERDAY worked her way to the front before reaching the backstretch, set the pace towards the inside, being rated right along, spurred away from the field after entering the far turn, was put to desperate hand encouragement turning for home, yielded near the sixteenth pole and weakened steadily thereafter. HOME RULE three wide around the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and rallied mildly.

TRAIL MAGIC brushed between rivals at the start, was a forward factor for three-quarters before tiring. SO MUCH HEART up in midpack, lost ground continuing along one-paced down the backstretch and around the far turn, angled outward heading into the lane and staged a mild comeback to improve position by mainly weak and tired ones. OSTENSIBLY had no rally. HEY HEY MAMA raced along the outside, tried to lug inward throughout the stretch, finally succeeding nearing the wire once the rider released his strong hold on the right rein. GRACE'N STYLE brushed at the break, handled each bend poorly, bearing out several paths to be widest off all around each. MOLLY MALONE faded after going a half. ELAROSE tracked inside and wilted.
