STAKES New York Stallion Series S. Black Type - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD ELIGIBLE FOR THE NEW YORK STALLION STAKES. For Colts and Geldings that have been fully subscribed to The New York Stallion Series (all eligibility requirements met by their three year old season) are eligible to this race. \$500 to enter and an additional \$500 to start. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% to be divided equally among the remaining finishers. Three year olds, 122 lbs.; older, 124 lbs. Non-winners of a Sweepstakes in 2012, allowed 2 lbs.; \$35,000 twice in 2012 allowed 4 lbs.; a sweepstakes or four races 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming and starter races not considered). Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey.

Footnotes

SPORTSWRITER sat reserved from well off the inside, crept up and made his presence felt more coming to the three-eighths pole, challenged in earnest and soon took over, kicked clear of the others opening up his biggest advantage during the run through the furlong grounds, dug in well to stave off the runner and preserve the decision. ANAPHYLAXIS four wide for most of the way around the turn, rallied willingly to procure the place. MAGGIE'S HADDER urged four wide into upper stretch, was up for the show. GAME TOKEN saved ground, paused in hand behind foes as the field headed into the stretch, launched a rail bid to grab the final major award. FRISKY WARRIOR was coaxed along from the inside while arguing for command, faced heavy pressure by the midway point on the turn, held on for a little while longer as a pace factor then weakened. KELTIC FIGHTER pressed the issue from the outside, had another pair join up and increase the pressure about halfway around the bend, with the remaining rivals likewise in close proximity, tired after entering the stretch. DAVE'S SHADOW four wide at the three-eighths pole, started to back away after going a half.
