WHAT'S THE RECORD entered the turn from the three path, got let out a notch in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, entered the stretch four wide and having felt the whip a couple of times, closed in readily during the ensuing furlong, kept onward, grabbing away the advantage in the late stages and edging away. TALK THERAPY raced three wide on the turn, bid from there as the field headed for the top of the stretch, left the eighth pole as the new leader, maintained the front for just over a sixteenth more before relinquishing to the winner. BULLNOSE BRICK loped along for nearly three-quarters, was fanned five wide into upper stretch, displayed a good kick down the center of the strip to earn the show. SOUTHBEACHSANDY broke open the gate, was kept under a snug hold as the gate door was closed, proceeded to come away with no apparent mishap, loosely stalked the leader from the outside for the opening half, began to crank up the pressure upon reaching the turn, grabbed a slim advantage at the quarter pole, had it taken away before going another furlong, then weakened steadily. ALI'S WINNER chased four wide on the turn and had no rally. CRAFTY CONCORDE quickly grabbed the advantage and was sent over to the rail, set the initial splits being only lightly pressed, came under heavier pressure by the time he reached the quarter pole, gave into it readily and faltered. ROARING CONQUEST raced from off the inside and folded.
