BELLA BOURIE quickly opened a clear lead, set the pace along the inside and was outfinished. TALLONSY was off slowly, raced greenly and had no rally. GRAY FEVER raced inside and tired. MAYMONT raced greenly while wide and tired. KNIGHT DEB tired.
