 FOR COLTS AND GELDINGS THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD ELIGIBLE TO THE NEW YORK STALLION STAKES. Colts and Geldings that have been fully subscribed to The New York Stallion Series (all eligibility requirements met by their three year old season) are eligible to this race. \$350 to pass the entry box, \$400 to start. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. Three year olds, 122 lbs.; older 124 lbs. Non-winners of \$35,000 on the turf in 2009 allowed 2 lbs.; \$35,000 on the turf in 2008 or \$30,000 twice in 2009, 4 lbs.; \$30,000 in 2008 or four races lifetime, 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming and starter races not considered). A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, this race will be run at One Mile on the Main Track.).

Footnotes

RUFFINO led briefly, stalked three wide to the turn, raced just off the pace from outside into upper stretch then dug in determinedly to wear down the runner-up in the final strides. PRETTY BOY FREUD moved up along the rail to take the lead on the backstretch, shook loose in upper stretch, led into deep stretch and yielded grudgingly. HAMMOCK saved ground just off the early pace, waited briefly on the turn and finished evenly. GOOD PROSPECT checked a bit in the early stages and was never close thereafter. PENNINGTON pressed the pace from outside to the top of the stretch and tired. GARGANTUA was never a factor after breaking slowly. MINNIE PUNT was outrun to the turn and drifted out while giving way in upper stretch.
