MY WANDY'S GIRL got away from the starting gate a beat slow, was mildly hand urged into the middle of the pack before having the pilot tap on the brakes after achieving the goal, proved ratable while stalking the leader from the two path, well within striking distance throughout the run around the bend, turned for home with clear passage awaiting her, was cued up with some cross-reining by the rider and took off after all front runners.gained the advantage a short distance past the eighth pole and edged away, under a light drive. MILDLY OFFENSIVE was hand urged after the start to grab the top, cut the pace from the two path, facing honest resistance all the while, got called upon leading the field into the stretch, reached the furlong marker on nearly dead even terms with the eventual winner, surrendered to that one's challenged shortly afterwards, but showed plenty enough the rest of the way to be second best. KID KATE departed the backstretch from the three path, issued a challenge from there coming to the five-sixteenths pole. flattened out and had to settle for the show award. ENCHANTE under encouragement entering the stretch four wide, lacked the needed response. CURLINA raced from off the inside, commenced the stretch run being three wide, failed to menace. WINNIE DIXIE vied for command from the inside for about a half, doing so after having been asked for some run by the top of the turn, faltered.
