SANTO MIO was outrun early, rallied three wide approaching the stretch and was along late from the outside, driving. CHEROKEE RACER raced close up inside and finished gamely on the rail. DEVIL'S FIDDLER contested the pace along the inside and continued on gamely to the finish. TOTALLY PRIVATE raced four wide and finished well outside. HOME ON THE HILL contested the pace while between rivals and weakened in the final furlong. BORDER FIRE contested the pace while three wide and tired in the stretch. ROMANTIC NOVEL raced four wide and had no rally. LADY CAREN chased inside and tired. CHARMS WAY hesitated at the start, raced close up while four wide and tired in the stretch. HEY HEY SUNNY broke awkwardly, raced inside and tired.
