GOLD MINISTER was hustled along outside, dug in determinedly in the stretch and was up in the final stride. RAPID RICKEY contested the pace from the outside, drew clear in the stretch, took a clear lead into deep stretch and was caught on the line. SOUTHACK was outrun early, raced three wide and finished well outside. THIS IS TRUE was hustled from the gate, contested the pace along the inside and weakened in the final furlong. HONEST EXPECTATION was outrun early, altered course in the stretch and drifted out in the final furlong. PRINCE TUTTA was outrun early, raced three wide and had no rally. MR RETSOF raced inside and had no rally. RAPPERS DEELITE had no response when roused. LITTLE SULEYMAN tired after a half mile.
