RESEARCH REPORT gave chase from the outside, reeled in the former runaway leader during the run through the furlong grounds, dug in well to hold off the runner up in the late stages. GOLDEN TORNADO three wide on the turn, finished with good energy to secure second. FU PEGS BABY saved ground until the quarter pole, angled to be three wide by the three-sixteenths pole, flattened out in the final furlong. GRANGERARDO spurred away from the field making his way to the backstretch, set the opening spits from off the inside but was down along the rail by the half mile pole, had the winner hack in half his earlier advantage, got overhauled during the initial portion of the stretch drive and steadily weakened. GO TO THE NET three wide departing the backstretch, lacked the needed response. APIANUS saved ground on the turn and tired. DOODLEMAN raced along the outside and folded. KOMISAREK was always outrun.
