Footnotes

SHOULD MAKE IT moved up after the break to grab the early advantage, argued to maintain it from along the inside, was put to encouragement while drifting into the two path for the commencement of the stretch run, edged away from the others, kept under active handling to the end. AUNT TIPSY underwent a three wide pursuit and rallied for the place. WESTERDAY pressed the issue from the two path and held on well enough for the show. MY BROWN EYED BABY tracked the winner while taking the inside route, was put to some encouragement slightly more than halfway around the turn, scurried into contention by the quarter pole, remained a prominent factor for nearly an additional furlong then flattened out. LADY JARLYN loped along while saving ground down the backstretch, picked up the pace when let out a notch at the three-eighths pole, got angled outward a sixteenth later, tipped wider and wider until placed three to four wide by upper stretch, ducked sharply over to the inside with an eighth to go, rode the rail until the sixteenth pole before put into the two path, went fairly evenly after all the maneuvering was finally done. WINMOR GOLD saved ground and failed to menace. DEFERRAL fought against the bit leaving the starting gate, settled down by the end of the backstretch, raced along the outside and folded. PROFITSHARON three wide departing the backstretch, gave way.
