STARFORADAY saved ground towards the rear, came under light hand urging at the three-eighths pole, advanced on the top pair nearing the quarter pole, swung four wide at that station, seized command a furlong out and drew away hand urged through the stretch to score decisively. HEWITTS dueled from the start while two to three wide, widened away from the rest in tandem with his main pace foe from the three-eighths to the quarter pole, took command straightening for home as CRIBNOTE gave way, got confronted by the aforementioned rival nearing the furlong grounds, was displaced at that station, kept on mildly while clear for the place honors. BLUE CREEK towards the rear just off the inside, came under urging three furlongs out, swung five wide for home, offered up mild late energy for the show while never threatening the top. LINDELL A. C. tracked inside from mid pack, came under urging at the three-eighths, spun three wide for home and offered up a mild kick for the last major share. CRIBNOTE dueled with HEWITTS from the get go from the inside, widened away with that foe from the field at the three-eighths, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, came off the rail a path turning for home and gave way. VILLAS STORM three wide in close pursuit initially, came under urging three furlongs from the wire, swung four wide into the stretch, veered in under off sided stick work to the rail at the three-sixteenths and tired. GALAXY KAT bobbled at the start slightly, settled just off the pace just off the inside between rivals showing brief speed, retreated in the latter portion of the turn and tired.
