Footnotes

EZPZ LEMON SQUEEZE strung out three wide on the opening bend, worked out a tuck closer to the rail along the backstretch, sat reserved for nearly six furlongs with an inadvertent bumping incident with VENDOR FINANCING midpoint on the backstretch being the only noteworthy happening all the while, was asked for some run and began to angle outward late on the second turn, gained ground readily on BLUEGRASS RUMOR making her way from upper to midstretch, kept up the pursuit on the aforementioned rival, wrested away the advantage in the final seventy yards, then just reached the wire in time to prevent the runner up from being the victor. SUNDAE'S A MEESE contently rode the rail until upper stretch, altered course to be four wide during the run through the furlong grounds, charged home with a strong kick, missed. BLUEGRASS RUMOR broke alertly and quickly established control, was

successfully guided over to the inside before reaching the end of the homestretch, cut the pace, being rated by the rider on an open lead, remained under those conditions for just over three-quarters, felt some pressure building up spinning into the stretch and got let out in response to it, emerged from the furlong grounds with none latched on, came under heavy pressure from the winner shortly afterwards, showed good determination before yielding reluctantly in the final seventy yards, then lost out on the place honors due to the second place finisher's strong finish. BONATINI raced along the outside, rallied into contention after entering the stretch, held on well in the last eighth en route to grabbed the final major slice of the pot. GRISAILLE outrun for the opening three-quarters, swung four wide into upper stretch and mustered up a mild response to outfinish half of the field. IRISH WEDDING tracked the pacesetter without ever applying any real pressure and got outfinished. VENDOR FINANCING took the inside route, bumped with winner while running along the backstretch, weakened after departing the eighth pole. PROUD DAME lunged taking her first step out of the starting gate, raced towards the inside and had no rally. SILENT JOY swung three wide into the backstretch and was never heard from. DARN THAT TRIP fought against the bit for much of the way towards the opening turn, gave tepid chase from the outside until the quarter pole and wilted.
