Footnotes

IDLE AMERICAN sat well reserved from off the inside, under a firm hold for much of the opening three-quarters, turned for home and was forced to idle behind a wall of horses a short distance up ahead, saw a promising lane by midstretch and got tipped outward in the direction of it, picked up speed noticeably after completing this maneuver, roared by the runner up in deep stretch to prove best. KHARAFa tracked the pacesetter while sitting in the pocket, vacated the premises at the end of the run down the backstretch, ranged up towards QUICK MONEY from the midway point on the second turn onward, turned for home having successfully hitched up to that foe and got set down, fought his way to a slim advantage by deep stretch, proved powerless to match the winner's explosive kick, but gamely won the war for second honors. QUICK MONEY bumped lightly with HEAR THE FOOTSTEPS at the start, was hand urged to secure the front, then put to rating tactics after having done so, was gradually guided over to the rail, settling there before reaching the opening bend, showed the way, rating kindly on an open lead, felt some pressure for the first time approaching the quarter pole, entered the stretch being heavily tested by the runner up and was asked for a response, surrendered the lead after an invigorating fight from upper stretch to deep stretch. HEAR THE FOOTSTEPS made light contact with QUICK MONEY leaving the starting gate, took up position in midpack, chased the previously mentioned rival near the two path for six furlongs, entered the stretch and was outfinished. THE THINKER three wide on the first turn, was strung out one path wider on the

subsequent one, held on reasonably well to the end en route to minor spoils despite all the loss of real estate. GIMME CREDIT between rivals, failed to launch a serious bid. FORTISSI MORE saved ground and had no rally. ROCKY F was never in contention. WRITINGONTHEWALL prominently placed while three wide on the far turn, folded. IMAGE OF DISCO in the three path around both turns, tired.
