MATTERHORN rumbled his way into midpack by the end of the chute, achieving the goal without need of encouragement, departed the backstretch from the three path, wedged in the middle of line up compromised of five, kicked away and ranged up dangerously during the later stages of the run around the bend, latched on to the runner up as the pair spun into the stretch, got called upon, forged his way to a sliver of an advantage by the furlong marker, continued heads apart with the nemesis before edging away in the final seventy yards. HARPOON bobbed after the start, grabbed the lead shortly after the start, took up residence in the two path, had WOELF DEN cruise up from down along the rail nearing the end of the backstretch, bested that foe only to have the winner emerge as a threat as the third fraction was being completed, got set down for the drive home, fought with vigor against the top one, pinned down along the fence during the initial phases of the struggle, remained on even terms before getting shaken off for good well inside the sixteenth marker. WOELF DEN took the inside route for three-quarters, vied briefly for command leaving the half mile pole, fell back despite getting for run for a good portion of the way from the top of the turn to its end, got sharply angled three wide into the stretch, proved no match for the top twosome, but held on reasonably well for the show award. TONALIST three wide and asked by the three-eighths pole, commenced the stretch two paths wider, lacked the needed response. PATTY AND NOOCHE gave chase from the two path, swung three wide into the stretch, came up empty. HOWL raced along the outside and failed to menace. CONSISTENCY saved ground and was outrun. SMARTY BURNS stacked five wide at the half mile pole, folded. SOUPER LUCKY in the four path and positioned between opponents leaving the backstretch, gave way.
