EMINENT TALE established command soon after the start, carved the pace towards inside under a snug hold until the quarter pole, sped off from the competition when given some rein in upper stretch, then continued to lengthen away, being ridden out. FREUDS ANA STREAK took the inside route, cut the corner under encouragement, angled outward in midstretch attempting to close in all the while, but proved to be no match. UNCLE SMOKEY urged from the get-go, saved ground during the opening half, mustered up enough stretch energy to be along for the show. LETSHOOTPOOL urged chasing the leader three wide for a half, tired. FOR WES lacked the needed response. VERBOSITY a bit reluctant to load into the starting gate, accompanied the leader from the outside until upper stretch and folded. LAKE SONG was never involved.
