GRAND STRATEGY was taken hold after bobbling at the start, went on to assume a forward position and locked up in a duel with ULTIMO PRINCIPE while travelling in the two path, was still battling hard with the aforementioned rival as the closest pursuers began to edge closer late on the turn, clung tenaciously to a slim advantage as the three front runners made their way to the eighth pole, dug in with good determination to preserve the decision. DAVID THE GREAT stalked the contested pace while placed slightly off the inside, was taken outward a bit and wedged into position between opponents in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, turned for home in hot pursuit of the leader, challenged between rivals during the run through the furlong grounds, loomed boldly only a neck or so behind the winner with an eighth to go, failed to gain any additional ground and had to settle for the place. THE FED EASED perched four wide off the speed duel, came home willingly en route for the show. AWESOME ARCENO placed three wide at the the five-sixteenths pole in preparation for the stretch run, lacked the necessary response. BAMBI BOUND sat in the pocket, tracking the pace combatants, all the while ignoring an inviting hole down along the rail, was given some rein and finally availed of that passageway as the field headed for the quarter pole, issued a bid from upper to midstretch, failed to sustain it and flattened out. SHMOOZ TALKER brushed with ULTIMO PRINCIPE at the start, was unhurried for the opening half, swung six wide into upper stretch, improved position by a pair of weak and tired ones. I'VE GOT THE FEVER came in a step at the start and was pulled off the nearest opponent, sat near the back of the pack for nearly a half, was angled five wide into the stretch, failed to have an impact. ULTIMO PRINCIPE broke in slightly, making light contact with SHMOOZ TALKER, was hustled to the front, disputed the pace three wide until the quarter pole, and gave way.
